INTRODUCTION

The Belgian Rallyesim Championship is a fictitious championship based on the partial operating principle of the Belgian Rally Championship. So some real championship rules have been adapted, simplified or ignored to facilitate the running of the championship. Three championships as well as two Trophies are offered; the Kroon-Oil BRC (BRC), the Pirelli Junior BRC (JBRC), the Yokohama Historic BRC (HBRC), the Criterium BRC (CBRC), the Clio Trophy Belgium and the M-Cup.

RALLY PROCESS

The events take place on 1, 2 or 3 separate days.

The road books are written with a number of races and assistance, if possible, identical to the real rallies organized in 2021.

The use of different road surfacing is possible in the same rally

The damage is set to "reduced".

There are 1 car repair per day.

Pilots engaged in NCM - NCE classes score points for the CBRC.

Junior BRC competes on RC4-R2 cars.

Clio Trophy Belgium competes on Renault Clio Rally5 - RC5

M-Cup competes on BMW M3 E30 and BMW M3 E36

Pilots engaged in RC1 class do not score.

CAR CHANGES

The authorized number of changes of car during the season is fixed at 3. The changes are counted as from the 1st day of the 1st event of the calendar of the competition. Any change of class, causes the stopping of the points in the appropriate classifications.

RANKINGS

The following rankings are available:

- "BRC" general classification: "RC1 / RC2 / RC3 / RC4 / RC5 / RGT"
- "Historic" general classification: "HC4 / HC3 / HC2 / HC1"
- "Criterium" general classification: "NCM / NCE"
- General classification "Junior": "R2"
- Rankings by class: RC1, RC2, RC3, RC4, RC5, RGT, HC4, HC3, HC2, HC1, NCM, NCE
- General classification "Ford Fiesta Sport Trophy": " Ford Fiesta R2, R2J, R2T"
- General classification "M-Cup" : BMW M3 E30 and BMW M3 E36

ALLOCATION OF POINTS

The points scored in the championship are the cumulative points of the general standings and class.

They are distributed as such:

- Overall standings: Allocation of points to the first 8 cars: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1
- Classification by class: Allocation of points to the first 8 cars: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1
- Trophy standings: Allocation of points to the first 8 cars: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1

As a reminder :

Pilots engaged in RC2 - RC3 - RC4 - RC5 - RGT classes score points for the BRC.

Pilots engaged in HC4 - HC3 - HC2 - HC1 classes score points for the HBRC.

Pilots engaged in NCM - NCE classes score points for the CBRC.

Pilots engaged in R2 - Rally4 cars score points for the JBRC

Pilots engaged in RC1 class do not score. (Only for RC1 standings)
